- Grade 12 Certificate, with passes in Mathematics, Physical Science and English
- A National Vocational Certificate Level 2
- The following minimum N2 examination results:

Mathematics	55%
Trade Related Theory	55%
Engineering Science	55%
Engineering Drawings / Ind. Electronics	55%
