

**SOME ALIEN INVASIVE PLANTS (& ONE SIMILAR INDIGENOUS SPECIES)**



**Photo 1.** The alien invasive *Lantana camara* with flowers and unripe fruit. The plants must be destroyed before the fruit is formed to prevent seed being spread.



**Photo 2.** *Lantana camara* with ripe fruit, which is readily eaten and spread by birds. Note the square thorny stems, which help identify this alien species.



**Photo 3.** An indigenous species of Lantana that is not invasive and must **not** be removed. The stems are round and furry, and the flowers are not as brightly coloured as the alien *Lantana camara* in photos 1 & 2.
