LISBON – Portugal aiming to overcome its split personality and make a place in the Cup quarter-finals. minimum objectives.

The Portuguese have been the Jekyll and Hyde of European football in recent years, brilliant at the moment, awful the next.

Even though they were World Cup winners under coach Luiz Felipe Scolari, Portugal has steadily developed an exciting squad since taking over three years ago. consistency has remained elusive.

At Euro 2004, Portugal, for example, Scolari's team beat Spain, England and Holland – but ended losing twice to eventual winners, lowly Greece.

In 2006 World Cup qualifiers, they scored a 2-2 draw against Liechtenstein – and walloped Russia 7-0 days later.

And in recent friendly they brushed aside Northern Ireland – then drew with Northern Ireland.

Overall, though qualifying was a breeze for the Portuguese and they won their group by 10 points, amassing 30 in 12 games.
