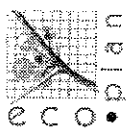


Environmental Assessment & Public Meetings

Public Meetings will be held to introduce the project and environmental study, and to hear public concerns:-

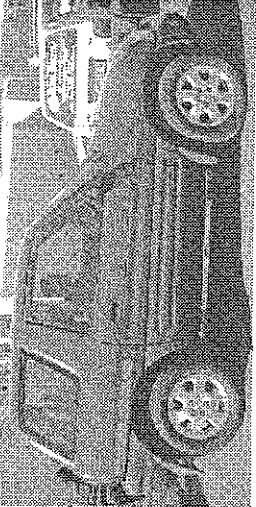
