Competition Rules:

- Only Namibian schools may take part in the competition
- Only primary and secondary schools may take part in the competition
- Requirement: Submit a profile on your school's environmental project. Submissions can be in writing and/or pictorial. Profiles/proposals should be written in English, and should be clear, clean and presentable
- Only one entry per school is allowed
- Only the winning schools, per category, will be contacted by NamPower
- No proposal shall be returned
- Ensure that the proposal contains a contact person from the school, in addition to the contact details of the school principal
