DISTRIBUTION OF CFLs - ANNOUNCEMENT

The Ministry of Mines and Energy, the Electricity Control Board and NamPower are in the process of implementing different Demand Side Management (DSM) initiatives to address the power supply shortages in the country. The first phase of the DSM initiatives will commence with the free distribution of 900 000 energy savings bulbs (CFLs) to residential electricity consumers in the country as from 29 October 2007.

WHO QUALIFIES FOR CFLs?

- Paying customer of a Town Council / REDs or Municipalities
- Residential Customers only

WHAT PROOF IS NEEDED

- October 2007 Electricity/Municipal Bill or AVM Card and receipt
- Proof of ownership of residential property
- Five (5) used incandescent bulbs
