

INITIATIVE THAT WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED FOR GRANTS

- 1.1 Generalised request sent to various organisation, will not be considered ***“To Whom it may Concern”*** type of requests.
- 1.2 Initiatives that are for individual gain/profit, such as informal street vendors, hair salons, shops and any other initiatives regarded profit making business/company.
- 1.3 Project for the benefit of private schools
- 1.4 Operational cost request, such as rental fees, wages, salaries, project starting capital, tours
- 1.5 One-time event sponsorships, vehicles except for school buses, tuitions fees or bursaries
- 1.6 NamPower employees, spouses and biological or legally adopted children
- 1.7 Organisation where NamPower employees hold shares
- 1.8 Individual / Private Schools excluding community kindergartens
- 1.9 Initiatives that discriminate based on race, colour, sexual orientation, physical disability
- 1.10 Labour/Trade unions, Traditional Authorities, Religious, military, surveillance equipment or law enforcement activities, faith-based or political organisations/groups with political affiliation.
- 1.11 The promotion of products or services that may be harmful to users/environment.
- 1.12 Acts of terrorism.
- 1.13 Events related to trade expo's, trade fairs, flea markets, pop ups shows, fashion shows, exhibitions shows, talent shows, music shows, concerts, graduation events, weddings, funerals, movie premieres, cultural festivals, sports and sports infrastructural development and refurbishment (with exemption to Disability Sport Namibia).
- 1.14 Construction of houses/dwellings
- 1.15 Donation of food items except for soup kitchens
- 1.16 Foundation shall not align itself with any project/initiative/event that is either directly or indirectly associated with any product/action that could be damaging to NamPower's image.
- 1.17 Any other initiative/projects that are not falling under Foundation focus areas
