**POWER OUTAGE IN WINDHOEK AND SURROUNDING AREAS, 4 JUNE 2018**

NamPower wishes to inform its customers and the public at large that it experienced a power outage today (4 June 2018) at 12:56 which affected the city of Windhoek and its surrounding areas.

The power outage was caused by a broken conductor at Hoffnung Sub Station, located 18 kilometers east of Windhoek. This consequently caused a trip at Van Eck Sub Station, affecting all power lines which supply Windhoek and its surrounding areas.

Power supply to the City of Windhoek was restored at 14:14, while power supply to Finkenstein, Hoffnung and surrounding areas is yet to be restored.

The public is cautioned to treat all power lines and electrical points as live at all times, as power supply can be restored without prior notification.

NamPower apologises to its customers and the public in general for any inconvenience that the outage may have caused.
