The Government of Namibia has received funding from the World Bank to finance the Namibia Transmission Expansion and Energy Storage (TEES) Project (P177328) and intends to apply part of the proceeds to eligible payments for goods, works, non-consulting services and consulting services to be procured under this project.

The objective of the project is to strengthen Namibia's transmission network and enable integration of renewable energy generation, and consists of the following three components: (i) **Component 1** will support the engineering, procurement and construction of the Auas - Kokerboom II 400 kV transmission line and substation works, including primary and secondary plant; (ii) **Component 2** will support the engineering, procurement and construction of a utility-scale BESS for an estimated capacity/energy of approximately 45 MW/90 MWh to be installed at Lithops substation; (iii) **Component 3** will finance technical assistance activities to (i) improve the risk profile of NamPower's pipeline Renewable Energy (RE) projects and (ii) enhance socio-economic impacts of the utility's projects.

Works and Goods that will use an open international approach to market include transmission line and associated substation works, BESS works, and selected transmission line and substation materials.

Consultancy Services that will use an open international approach to market include supervision and project management of the BESS works as well as the various technical assistance activities.

Procurement of contracts financed by the proceeds of the World Bank grant will be conducted through the procedures as specified in the World Bank's Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers (July 2016) (Procurement Regulations), 5th Edition, September 2023 and is open to all eligible firms and individuals as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
